From May 17 through 23, neighborhood grocer commits to match up to \$50,000 in customer donations

**Portland, Ore. (May 8, 2023) –** From May 17 through 23, New Seasons Market will host its annual Hunger Relief Match (previously known as Hunger Match Weekend) benefiting 10 local nonprofits fighting food insecurity. The Portland-based grocer will match up to \$50,000 in customer donations throughout the week, ultimately doubling each dollar with the opportunity to give more than \$100,000.
